Dr. Edward Lilly Presents Seminar on Knee Pain

Lilly, an orthopedic surgeon with fellowship training in knee and hip replacement, will cover the latest advances in the total knee replacement procedures and describe the knee replacement and recovery process offered at the Pardee Center for Joint Replacement.
