Pardee Pavilion offers trial visits

(Hendersonville, NC) The Pardee Pavilion, an adult day health services center located in Flat Rock, is offering trial visits to give participants and their caregivers the opportunity to experience the Pavilion first-hand.

“This is the perfect opportunity for caregivers and their loved ones to learn more about the Pavilion and determine if it would be beneficial to them,” said Karla Reese, director of the Pardee Pavilion. “Pardee Pavilion provides adult health services during the day, which offers caregivers time away while their loved one enjoys activities and the companionship of others. Through offering quality daytime care, we are able to provide support to family caregivers.”

According to Reese, Pardee Pavilion offers a safe, protective and stimulating environment that provides daytime activities, health care and health monitoring, healthy meals and socialization for adults with physical or mental impairments.

Services include health monitoring, meals, snacks and personal care assistance. Benefits to participants include: planned and structured activities, socialization, wellness and health screenings, peaceful areas for those who prefer to rest, secured areas for walking and gardening activities, assistance with medication administration and personal care. Light breakfast, a noon meal and afternoon snack are provided.

The Pavilion is located in Flat Rock, next to the Pardee Care Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation, on College Drive. Pardee Pavilion is open Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. until 5:30 p.m. Participant's per day rate is based upon the level of care required. The Pavilion's family services coordinator will complete an individual assessment of needs and schedule an initial trial visit to the center for new participants. The cost for a trial visit is \$30.
