Pardee to hold Diabetes Awareness Day event

(Hendersonville, NC) Pardee Hospital will host a Diabetes Awareness Day on Wed., Nov. 17, from 10 a.m. until 12:30 p.m., at the Pardee Health Education Center located inside the Blue Ridge Mall.

Attendees will learn about diabetes and how to manage the disease at this free event. Free blood pressure, body fat analysis and foot screenings will be offered. A1C screenings will be available for \$20. In addition, healthcare professionals will be available to answer questions and provide information helpful in the self-management of diabetes. Registration is not required.

The [Pardee Health Education Center](#) is a unique community outreach program of the hospital that provides an array of services from health fairs and screenings to seminars and support groups. Last year, the center provided more than 10,000 free and low-cost screenings to community members.
