**Pardee host to American Red Cross disaster training**

*(Hendersonville, N.C.)* Pardee was host to the American Red Cross disaster training, “Just in Time Training”, on Friday, May 27 at the hospital. This training comes after the recent natural disasters that have devastated multiple areas of the nation. These disasters require large numbers of trained health service professionals to respond.

The American Red Cross offered the abbreviated training to qualify professionals to serve as American Red Cross Disaster Health Services Volunteers. All Health Services Workers must be properly licensed in order to volunteer.

Pending the completion of the training and health assessment, these volunteers are now eligible to deploy or work locally as service associates within the American Red Cross Disaster Health Services program.
