**Brian Seng, D.O., to discuss hip joint replacement
at Pardee Health Education Center**

(Hendersonville, N.C.) Brian Seng, D.O., with Hendersonville Orthopedic Associates, will discuss the procedure for replacing a hip joint at the Minimally Invasive Anterior Hip Replacement presentation on Friday, March 18, from 12 – 1 p.m. at the Pardee Health Education Center, located in the Blue Ridge Mall.

Minimally invasive surgery is an increasing trend that replaces the hip joint with prosthesis using a small incision. This type of procedure provides a number of benefits including minimal scarring, less post-operative pain and fewer days spent in the hospital. An anterior approach does not disturb the tissues and muscles surrounding the hip area, increasing mobility and resulting in a faster recovery.
