Peter Mangone M.D., pioneers arthroscopic lateral ankle ligament reconstruction

(Hendersonville, N.C.) Peter G. Mangone, M.D., of Blue Ridge Bone and Joint in Hendersonville, has been recognized as a pioneer in arthroscopic lateral ankle ligament reconstruction. This recognition comes after the acceptance of a manuscript Dr. Mangone co-authored, entitled “Arthroscopic Lateral Ankle Ligament Reconstruction,” to be featured in *Techniques in Foot and Ankle Surgery* later this year.

Mangone began his research in 2007, interested in developing new techniques for lateral ankle ligament reconstruction with a primary focus on minimally invasive arthroscopic procedures.

“I knew there had been great advancements in arthroscopic techniques for instability over the last twenty years in other joints such as the shoulder and the knee. I felt it was time to start bringing those concepts to the world of foot and ankle surgery,” says Mangone.

Dr. Mangone has also announced his partnership with Jorge Acevedo M.D., of West Palm Beach, Florida, to further develop this minimally invasive technique. Together, they soon plan to offer hands-on training to other surgeons in the United States and to the international community later this year.
