The Ageless Grace® program has been developed by Denise Medved, published author, international NIA education trainer, first degree black belt NIA instructor, Tai Chi teacher, AFAA certified personal trainer, Feng Shui consultant and international presenter and speaker.



“It is based on movement exercises that are natural and come with ease. These four realms (body, mind, spirit and emotions) when in balance create health and well-being, reduce stress, keep the mind agile and the body responsive and allow the body to function at its optimal range of motion throughout the duration of the participant’s life.
