Albers named medical director of Wound Healing Center

(Hendersonville, N.C.) Charles Albers, M.D., FACS, a board-certified surgeon with Carolina Surgeons in Hendersonville, has been named medical director of the Wound Healing Center at Pardee Hospital.

In this role, Dr. Albers will lead the team at the center in providing specialized care for patients with acute and chronic wounds of all types. Dr. Albers received his medical degree from Baylor College of Medicine in Houston, Texas, and completed a residency at Medical College of Georgia in Augusta.

The Wound Healing Center at Pardee is a multidisciplinary team of physicians and nurses trained in the treatment and management of acute and chronic wounds. Patients are treated holistically by performing a complete wound assessment, addressing underlying problems, education for prevention and treatment, and collaboration/consultation with primary care physicians as well as other ancillary services.
