Local physician to discuss benefits of delayed umbilical cord clamping

(Hendersonville, N.C.) Justin Price, M.D., of Pardee Hendersonville Family Health Center, will present “Benefits of Delayed Umbilical Cord Clamping” on Tue., Aug. 25 from 7 until 8 p.m. at the Pardee Health Education Center in the Blue Ridge Mall.
