Local orthopedic surgeon to discuss anterior hip replacements

(Hendersonville, N.C.) Amal Das, M.D., an orthopedic surgeon with [Hendersonville Orthopaedic Associates](#), will offer a free presentation about anterior hip replacements at the Pardee Health Education Center on Fri., May 7, from 2 until 3:30 p.m.

Dr. Das will discuss the anatomy of the hip and the steps for replacing a hip using the anterior method. The anterior approach to hip replacement surgery allows the surgeon to reach the hip joint from the front of the hip as opposed to the lateral (side) or the posterior (back) approach. This way, the hip can be replaced without detachment of muscle from the pelvis or femur during surgery. This allows patients to immediately bend their hip freely and bear full weight when comfortable, resulting in a more rapid return to normal function. Dr. Das graduated from the Indiana University School of Medicine and completed his residency at the University of Tennessee College of Medicine. He is board certified by the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery and a fellow of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons. He completed the first study in the United States on glucosamine and chondroitin sulfate for the treatment of arthritis and has received national recognition



for his work. Dr. Das is associated with the [Pardee Hospital Center for Joint Replacement](#), which is dedicated to the treatment and rehabilitation of patients undergoing hip, knee and shoulder replacement surgery.

The [Pardee Health Education Center](#) is a unique community outreach program of the hospital that provides an array of services from health fairs and screenings to seminars and support groups. Last year, the center provided more than 10,000 free and low-cost screenings to community members.
