Dr. Suzanne Hall offer free presentation on shoulder injuries

(Hendersonville, N.C.) Suzanne Hall, M.D., an orthopaedic surgeon with [Appalachian Orthopaedics](#), will offer a free presentation on how shoulders work, techniques to avoid injury and the latest treatment options. The presentation will be held at the Pardee Health Education Center on Wed., Oct. 6 at from 1 until 2:30 p.m.

She is board-certified in orthopedic surgery and is a fellowship trained shoulder specialist. She is on the active medical staff of Pardee Hospital and is currently accepting new patients.
