Physician to offer free shoulder presentation

(Hendersonville, N.C.) Suzanne Hall, M.D., orthopedic surgeon with [Appalachian Orthopaedics](#), will offer a presentation on how shoulders work, techniques to avoid injury and the latest treatment options. This free presentation will be held at the Pardee Rehab & Wellness Center on Wed., Sept. 15 at 1 p.m.

Dr. Hall graduated from the University of Massachusetts School of Medicine and completed her residency at the Bronx Lebanon Hospital in New York. She is board certified in orthopedic surgery, and is a fellowship trained shoulder specialist. She is on the active medical staff of Pardee Hospital and is currently accepting new patients.

Cardiopulmonary rehab and diabetes education staff includes registered nurses, a registered clinical exercise physiologist, a respiratory therapist, a registered dietitian, and a certified diabetes educator.
