Local medical oncologist to discuss prevention and early detection of cancer

(Hendersonville, N.C.) William Medina, M.D., of Hendersonville

Hematology & Oncology, will present “Keeping Well: Prevention and Early Detection of Cancer” at the Pardee Health Education Center on Mon., June 29 from 12:30 until 1:30 p.m.

Much of the suffering and death caused by cancer could be prevented by making small changes to everyday life. In this free presentation, Dr. Medina will discuss simple measures everyone can take to help prevent and detect early stages of cancer.

Dr. Medina earned his medical degree from the University of Kentucky College of Medicine in Lexington, Ky., and completed his residency at the Medical University of South Carolina in Charleston, S.C. He also completed a fellowship at Yale University in New Haven, Conn. He is board certified in medical oncology and internal medicine. Dr. Medina serves on the medical staff at the Comprehensive Cancer Center at Pardee Hospital, the only community
