Local orthopedic surgeon to discuss partial knee replacements

(Hendersonville, N.C.) Brian Seng, D.O., orthopedic surgeon with [Hendersonville Orthopaedic Associates](#), will present “Minimally Invasive Partial Knee Replacement” at the Pardee Health Education Center on Fri., Oct. 23, from 12:30 until 2 p.m.

Dr. Seng will discuss the pathophysiology of knee arthritis including new and innovative techniques for the treatment of end-stage arthritis, specifically the concept of partial knee replacement. Registration for this free presentation is required by calling 1-866-790-WELL (9355).

Dr. Seng received his degree in osteopathy from Kirksville College of Osteopathic Medicine in Kirksville, Mo. He completed his internship and residency at St. John Oakland Hospital in Madison Heights, Mich. Dr. Seng completed his fellowship in adult hip and knee reconstruction at Joint Implant Surgeons in Columbus, Ohio. Dr. Seng’s medical career began during volunteer trips to Calcutta, India and Port-au-Prince, Haiti.

Dr. Seng specializes in less invasive techniques for hip and knee replacements and is affiliated with [Pardee Hospital’s Center for Joint Replacement](#), which is dedicated



to the treatment and rehabilitation of patients undergoing hip, knee and shoulder replacement surgery.
